Energy Consumption of a Clothes Dryer



- On average, clothes dryers use approximately 1,079 kilowatt hours of energy and emit 2,224 pounds of carbon dioxide each year.
- The electric clothes dryer is the fourth biggest household energy user and accounts for approximately 6% of the total electricity used in a household.

Advantages of Using a Clothesline

To name a few...

- You will see savings totalling anywhere from \$60 to \$120 on your energy bills each year, depending on your family size and how often you use your clothes line.



- Your clothing is not subject to the shrinkage and static electricity that a clothes dryer creates.



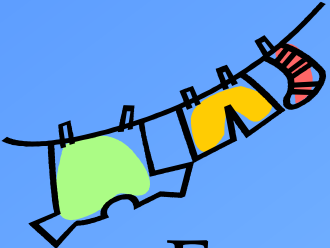
Advantages of Using a Clothesline (continued)

- Ultraviolet rays from the sun are an antiseptic and will kill any bacteria that weren't killed during your wash load.



- Hanging wash loads to dry inside your home can serve as a natural humidifier during dry winter months.

Hills Products

The following products will be available for purchase through Go Green Together in the Spring of 2011.

Traditional Rotary 42

- 42 metres of line, holds a full family wash.
- Portable after installation, arms fold up when not in use.
- Requires minimum of 4 metres of garden space.
- Galvanized steel tube, powder coat paint finish.



Hills Products (continued)

Rotary 500

- 56 metres of line, holds largest family load.
- Portable after installation.
- Requires minimum of 5 metres of garden space.
- Individual line tensioning.
- Largest removable clothesline available.



Hills Products (continued)

Sietro 6

- 39 metres of line with a maximum line extension of 6.5 metres.
- 6 lines extend and retract with automatic line tensioning.
- Corrosion resistant container.
- Ideal for hanging a large family wash.
